<p>This diminutive T-shaped vernacular bungalow features compatible additions of a complex shape. A projecting gabled porch with 4X4 columns presents the main elevation. Corner boards are extant, as are decorative details on the porch railings. Short, but elegant steps lead to the house from the sidewalk. The windows are 1/1 double-hung with bronze aluminum sliders. There are additions to the rear and south.</p> <p>A garage stands at the southwest end of the house.</p>
