The front gabled porch has rake board and molding, lancet windows on each side and an arched doorway. A flower box blooms under the large front window. An exterior chimney with stepped base snuggles in the corner of the porch entry and the front elevation. The north elevation has a small gabled bump out. Basement windows peek out from the foundation.</p> <p>The detached garage has been converted into living quarters. A white, wood picket fence surrounds the yard.</p>
