GEOGRAPHIC SETTING: Located above grade of South McLoughlin Boulevard, a heavily traveled State highway. At the south edge of the Canemah District.

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE: (Historical and/or architectural importance, dates, events, persons, contexts): The Spencer family purchased the land in this area in 1882; they also purchased the house next door (902 S. McLoughlin) at the same time. Ross Spencer was a laborer in Canemah in 1882, and was 46 years old; his wife's name was Belle, and they had a daughter, age 2. The house has been severely altered, and little architectural significance remains. The house is significant for its age.



