2. Role of advisory committee
 - a. 2-3 virtual meetings, optional public workshop
 - b. There are some changes that Oregon City is required to implement, and others where the City has choices to make. Advisory committee will inform these choices and ultimate code updates.
 - c. Ultimate goal: Recommendation on way forward for Planning Commission, City Commission
3. CFEC Overview and Oregon City requirements
 - a. City staff has indicated that Oregon City will pursue Option 3
 - b. Option 3 requires a reduction of parking mandates for several uses and in several locations, as well as several other reforms aimed at reducing the burden of parking mandates for development/redevelopment, and improving parking functionally and aesthetically.

5. Areas where OC has discretion/choices
 - a. Redevelopment of “underused” parking
 - b. Tree canopies vs. solar panels vs. fee-in-lieu for new parking
 - c. EV charging requirements
