

Historic Oregon Newspapers - Searching, Printing & More...

Search words and phrases:

- the phrase “within 5 words of each other” means that the first name and last name will be close to each other, and allow for middle names, initials, and maiden names.)
- the phrase “Any of the words” looks for hits on each word that is entered. A default ‘OR’ is entered between the words.
- the phrase “All of the words” searches for all of the search words appearing on one page. A default ‘AND’ is entered between the words
- the word “Phrase” looks for words in an exact order.
- Refining a search:
 - Limit your search to one newspaper, or select several titles clicking the mouse while holding the ctrl key
 - Limit your search to a specific year, month, or even day, using the begin date and end date lists provided. Use format: xx/xx/xxxx
 - Selecting the same begin month/day/year and end month/day/year will provide links to every page of all newspapers available for that specific date
 - To view front pages only, click the ‘only front page’ box

Using newspaper images from your search

- To enlarge or reduce images, click cursor in image and move scroll button on mouse
 - Or, to enlarge or reduce images, click onto the image
 - Or, to enlarge or reduce images, click on to + or – icons at the top of the page
- To move enlarged images, click onto image with cursor and move up, down, or sideways
- To restore image to original size, click onto home button (house icon)
- To get a full screen view, click onto the arrow-in-a-box icon.
- To return, click the arrow in- box icon again.

Printing sections from a newspaper image

- The red box on the inset(what does that mean) portrays the section of the newspaper page that is available to “clip”, or separate from the entire newspaper page
- Line up the article or section within the red box and click onto scissor icon at top in the tool bar
- Section will display with date, issue and persistent link and can be printed from the browser

Printing an entire newspaper page

- Using the browser print functions will print the portion of the newspaper that displays in the viewer box
- Converting to PDF and then clicking the printer icon at the bottom will provide a print of the entire page
- If you wish, you may display images from your search in PDF, text, or jpg
- The tool bar at the top has choices of PDF, text, or jpg format. Click onto your choice and the conversion will display.
