

What to expect during construction

General construction hours are 7:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. Monday through Friday.

- Contractor visits regarding rehabilitation plans (affected property owners have been contacted).
- Closure of Harrison St (local access only).
- Brief total loss of access to Harrison St initially during paving.
- Increased use of on-street parking on streets adjacent to the Harrison St closure.
- Loose gravel driving surfaces and steep drops (steep gravel ramps) at driveways and entrances to the Harrison St closure.
- Temporary staging or storage of construction materials and equipment.
- Noise, vibration, dust.

Construction is beginning near you


Road work and sewer construction begins the week of July 7 on Harrison Street.

Harrison Street construction details

The City of Oregon City is starting road and sewer repair work on Harrison Street between 7th Street and 9th Street. **This section of Harrison Street will be closed to through-traffic, with local access only, for up to 6 weeks.**

Harrison Street is in such poor condition that it needs to be completely rebuilt, and the sewer lateral pipes under Harrison Street are urgently in need of repair too. Before the road work can be done, the sewer pipes need to be fixed.

Crews will first remove the asphalt down to the road base, then do sewer lateral pipe repairs in the street, and finally return to rebuild and pave the road. Once the road is repaved, crews will come back to finish lateral pipe repairs on individual properties.



About the Larger McLoughlin Basin Project 1

Later in August, sewer repair crews will return to the greater McLoughlin neighborhood to begin the full McLoughlin Basin 1 Sewer Project. We expect to complete this project by June 2026.


McLoughlin Basin Sewer Project 1

This project is the first of a series of Inflow & Infiltration Sewer Projects in the McLoughlin sewer basin. It includes:

- Rehabilitating approximately 3,620 linear feet of sewer mainline pipes.
- Inspecting approximately 100 sewer lateral pipes and repairing or replacing any pipes that are in poor condition.
