



**NOTICE OF DECISION – LEGISLATIVE**

**APPLICANT:** City of Oregon City – Planning Division

**REQUEST:** Amend Title 16 and 17 of the Oregon City Municipal Code to Implement the Goals and Policies of State House Bill 2001 and Senate Bill 458 regarding Middle Housing.

**LOCATION:** City Wide

**DECISION:** May 18, 2022 after reviewing all of the evidence in the record and considering the recommendations of the Planning Commission, and the testimony of the public, the City Commission concluded that amendments to above-referenced Oregon Municipal Code sections considered as part of Planning File GLUA 22-0002/LEG-22-0001 complies and is consistent with the applicable requirements of the Oregon City Comprehensive Plan and Municipal Code, Statewide Rules and Land Use Goals; and voted 3-1 to approve the first reading of ORDINANCE NO. 22-1001. On June 1, 2022 the City Commission voted 4-0 to approve the second reading of ORDINANCE NO. 22-1001 and remand the file to the October 24, 2022 Planning Commission Meeting to review a second package of outstanding policy questions not needed for compliance with HB 2001.

(Ord. 98-1008 §1(part), 1998). The city commission decision is the city's final decision and is appealable to the land use board of appeals (LUBA) within twenty-one days of when it becomes final.*
