

E. Board and Commission Application

F. Boards and Commissions with Special Regulations

Several boards require special qualifications for appointment. For example, the Historic Review Board appoints one architect experienced in historic preservation, and no more than two voting members of the Planning Commission shall be engaged principally or involved in any aspect of the real estate field. In addition, no more than two voting members shall be engaged in the same kind of business, trade or profession.

G. Appointment to Board or Commission

Appointments of those Board and Commission members who are announced by the Mayor are announced at a City Commission meeting. For those appointments made by the Commission as a whole, the appointment will be voted upon in an open meeting. An Oregon City staff person will contact all new members with an orientation to the board or commission to assist in understanding and performing the valuable role.
