Citizens are encouraged to apply for seven open positions on the Oregon City Natural Resource Committee (NRC). The Natural Resource Committee assists in the review and implementation of plans and policies to protect, restore and enhance the environmental quality of Oregon City within the urban growth boundary ("UGB"). This Committee's role is to encourage conservation of natural resources and preservation and enhancement of ecosystems, open spaces and natural corridors within the Oregon City Urban Growth Boundary (UGB). The Committee recommends actions to the City Commission, the Planning Commission, and the Parks and Recreation Advisory Committee (PRAC). The committee also may review and comment on all land use applications that significantly impact natural resources and related projects and policies coming before the City Commission and Planning Commission.
