Oregon City, with a population of approximately 33,390 is located 12 miles south of Portland at the confluence of the Clackamas and Willamette rivers and serves as the county seat for Clackamas County. Portland International Airport is within 25 minutes via Interstate 205. Our City is situated in a region rich in a variety of outdoor recreation opportunities including fishing, hunting, skiing and boating. Oregon City has a strong historical heritage, which dates to 1844 when it became the first incorporated city west of the Rockies.
