

Frequently Asked Questions About...

SUMMER READING ASSEMBLY VISITS

What happens at an assembly visit?

We drop by a previously scheduled assembly for about 10 minutes to share basic information about how Summer Reading works, followed by a short interactive song with the students.

When can I schedule an assembly visit?

Any time after Memorial Day and before the last day of school. We clear our calendars to ensure we have time to visit everyone. We visit 1-2 assemblies at each school, depending on whether your school schedules one assembly for everyone or divides them by grade range.

How can we share summer reading information with families?

The district librarian typically prints copies of our Summer Reading flyer to share with all OCSD students via their school libraries. We can provide a master copy to non-OCSD schools for printing.

How do I schedule a summer reading assembly visit?
