

getting started

- 1. Download the app** from the App Store (iOS) or Play Store (Android).
- 2. Log in with your library card number and PIN** after you open the app. Your PIN is usually the last 4 digits of your phone number. Your library will be listed as Libraries in Clackamas County.
- 3. Search for a specific book or browse the collection.** Both apps offer options to browse by genre or subject and set filters to show only e-books, audiobooks, books available now, etc.
- 4. Tap Borrow to check out or Place Hold to place a hold.** You'll receive an e-mail when your hold is ready to check out.
- 5. Visit My Books (Cloud Library) or Shelf (Libby)** to download and read or listen to checked out books.
- 6. Tap and hold book covers in My Books or Shelf to return your books early.** Other readers will appreciate getting their holds sooner if they can! If you forget, the books return themselves at the end of the checkout period.


