


Before “Grateful Shred Day”

- 215 boxes were taken to an offsite long term storage facility**
- 1,290 gallons of paper shredded**
- 3,468,688 kilobytes of server space freed by deleting non-essential emails**
- 5,400 lbs of paper recycled**




