



OFF-LEASH DOG AREAS (OLDA)

Local dogs and their owners are invited to check out the designated off-leash dog areas (OLDA) at three park sites. The off-leash area is open for a one-year trial period to evaluate the opportunity for dog owners to have a designated off-leash area. The purpose of off-leash dog areas is to provide a safe and enjoyable recreational experience to dog owners/handlers and their dogs, while not impacting other park visitors or the environment.

A few factors will be taken into consideration when the City determines whether or not to make the off-leash areas permanent:

- * Satisfaction level of owners with the facility and experience
- * Other visitors in the park (visitors with and without dogs)
- * Safety of dogs and park visitors

OLDA Rules

- * Owners are legally responsible for the behavior of their dog(s) at all times
- * Dog waste must be cleaned up by their owners IMMEDIATELY
- * Dogs must be leashed while entering and exiting the park
- * Owners must be within the OLDA and supervising their dog with leash readily available
- * Aggressive dogs must be removed IMMEDIATELY
- * Dogs should be under voice control

Prohibited

- * Human & dog food or treats
- * Aggressive dogs
- * Sick dogs
- * Puppies (under 4 months)
- * Dogs in heat
