



# TYRONE S. WOODS MEMORIAL PARK PHASE I DEVELOPMENT

## ABOUT THE PARK

The 9-acre Tyrone S. Woods Memorial Park, located at 14491 South Glen Oak Road, will protect and restore natural resources while creating an engaging place for active and passive recreation for users of all ages and abilities. A thorough public engagement process was undertaken to create the master plan for the park which includes site amenities including winding looped pathways, open lawn areas, picnic shelter, benches, nature playground, pickleball courts, skate spot and a fenced off-leash dog park. Approximately 7 acres of the site will be developed as phase I.

## ABOUT TYRONE S. WOODS

Tyrone S. Woods was a native Oregonian and a 1989 graduate of Oregon City High School. He was a state champion wrestler and went on to serve his country as a US Navy SEAL. Tyrone perished in Benghazi on September 12, 2012, while serving with the CIA defending American lives.

## TIMELINE


### Spring-Fall 2019

Bid process and park construction will begin. Construction beginning in Spring 2020 with completion anticipated in September 2020.
