The exterior wall surfaces, including the porch posts, of this bungalow are completely shingled in wood. The house has a square footprint and has a side gable roof with shed dormer. A shed-roofed bay is attached to the side. Decorative features typically of the bungalow movement include eave brackets that pierce the bargeboard, exposed rafter tails, and an angularly arcaded front porch. The front is also graced with a large picture window with leaded glass transom.
