Description of Physical and Landscape Features:			
This 1-1/2 story c.1920 bungalow sits above the street and features a gable porch with tapered box columns and T&G ceiling, and eave returns. The siding is vinyl. Aluminum-window bays flank the porch. A waist-high concrete retaining wall surrounds the house at the sidewalk. A chimney pierces the eaves on the south side, and multiple projections mark the east elevation at the second story level. The windows are 3/1 and 6/1 wood double-hung with fixed aluminum storm windows. Large trees and ornamental plantings landscape all sides of the property.
