Description of Physical and Landscape Features:			
This c.1900 vernacular house is square in plan with a hip roof on the main structure. A full width front porch at the entrance has a flat roof supported by square truncated wood posts and is raised above the street level with a wood staircase, balustrade and railing. A wide frieze below the porch roof is decorated with a spindled rail and porch frieze. Multi-light vinyl window with a grid are present on all elevations. A rear addition has a hipped roof and aluminum sliding windows. A garage exists under the main structure. Alterations include a skylight in the hipped roof of the main structure on the south façade.
