GEOGRAPHIC SETTING: Occupies a large corner lot at the intersection of 15th and Jackson Streets. A mostly residential neighborhood. Other landmarks in the nearby vicinity are 1506 Jackson Street (Simmons Residence, 1890) and 1616 Jackson Street (Vonderahe Residence, 1895).

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE: (Historical and/or architectural importance, dates, events, persons, contexts): Andrew Wilson was a fireman for Crown-Willamette Paper Company. His wife's name was Rebecca. This house replaced an earlier one on the lot, which was extant in 1900. The house is typical of Oregon City bungalows of this era, and has retained integrity of materials. The house has not experienced siding and window alterations often seen in these houses today.



