STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE: (Historical and/or architectural importance, dates, events, persons, contexts): This house is definitely one of a kind. Evidently designed by its original owner, Jacob Hauck, as evidenced by an article in the Oregon City Enterprise. The house stands among a collection of smaller, simpler bungalows. This section (between 14th and Prescott) could almost be called "Bungalow Lane."





