GEOGRAPHIC SETTING: Occupies an interior lot of 14th Street, near its intersection with Main Street. A mostly commercial (redeveloped) area. This house is adjacent to Doc Holliday's Pub (tavern). One of only three residences remaining in the downtown area.

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE: (Historical and/or architectural importance, dates, events, persons, contexts): No biographical information was found on Mary Harris, the house's original owner. As a residence in the downtown commercial area, this house is threatened. It is a good example of the Oregon City vernacular house, with some bungalow features. The house is significant for its age and also somewhat for the fact that it is one of only three remaining residences in the downtown area.



