GEOGRAPHIC SETTING: Occupies a large interior lot on Pearl Street, two lots west of its
intersection with Myrtle Street, and on the west side of Molalla Avenue (Pearl Street
continues on the east side of Molalla). Next door is a large apartment complex, and
across the street is another apartment building. Other landmark at 311 Pearl Street.
STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE: (Historical and/or architectural importance, dates, events,
persons, contexts): Alfred Fisher (1873-1925), the original owner of 307 Pearl Street,
was a carpenter, born in Canada. His mother was August Moehnke, of the Oregon City
family of that name. The house is significant for its style, one of the best and most
beautifully crafted of the vernacular houses, including the sensitive later alterations.



