NOTEWORTHY LANDSCAPE FEATURES: None.
ASSOCIATED STRUCTURES: Garage facing Polk Street.
KNOWN ARCHAEOLOGICAL FEATURES: None.

GEOGRAPHIC SETTING: Occupies a standard-sized corner lot at the intersection of 8th and Polk Streets.. A residential neighborhood, although only one block from the bend in residential/commercial 7th Street where it becomes commercially-developed Molalla Avenue.

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE: (Historical and/or architectural importance, dates, events, persons, contexts): Clark Fuge came to Oregon from Illinois. He was a day laborer. The structures surrounding the Fuge House are much younger than it is, and are of a much more horizontal emphasis. This house retains all of its original features (siding, cornerboards, rakeboards and architrave molding trim). The front porch with blind balustrade and scuppers is most likely an alteration. The house also has a view of the Willamette Valley.



