NOTEWORTHY LANDSCAPE FEATURES: Hedge. Mature deciduous trees.

ASSOCIATED STRUCTURES: Garage on south side.

KNOWN ARCHAEOLOGICAL FEATURES: None.

GEOGRAPHIC SETTING: Occupies a prominent position at the corner of Holmes Lane and heavily-traveled Linn Avenue. This intersection is a four-way stop, making the house even more prominent. No other landmarks in the immediate vicinity, although further down Holmes Lane is the Rose Farm, Stafford House and Rilance House.

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE: (Historical and/or architectural importance, dates, events, persons, contexts): No specific biographical information was found on the house's original owners. The owner says the house may have been built by a family which owned a mill and lumber company. This house is one of the oldest in Oregon City, and certainly the oldest by far in the immediate vicinity. The house has significance for its age.





