GEOGRAPHIC SETTING: Located on South McLoughlin Boulevard, a heavily-traveled State highway. An area of mixed commercial and residential uses.

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE: (Historical and/or architectural importance, dates, events, persons, contexts): Narcissa (May) Bowers was the widow of Canemah laborer William Bowers, a native New Yorker. Narcissa was born in Oregon in 1856. She purchased this house in her old age. The house has been severely altered and retains few of its original characteristics.





