STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE: (Historical and/or architectural importance, dates, events, persons, contexts): No biographical informatin was found on Louise and George Melum, the house's first owners. The structure itself has no significance; however, the site was apparently an Indian encampment in the 1800's; artifacts have been found on the property.





