

## ARCHITECTURAL / PROPERTY DESCRIPTION

(Include expanded description of the building/property, setting, significant landscape features, outbuildings, and alterations)

Simple rectangular 1 1/2 story form, with gable facing 4th, and west side entry; sited below the street on steep lot west of unbuilt Apperson Street.

Exterior finish materials: Roofing: architectural grade composition shingles, center brick chimney with clay pot; channel siding with corner boards, rake boards; concrete foundation;

Windows: Typical: wood double hung 4/4 with exterior metal storm windows, plain casings, pedimented heads; south upper window is 1/1; lower angled bay window centered on south; stained glass window on west;

Alterations: West side [entry] deck and sun porch enclosure; shed roofed porch addition; north side deck at main level; south bay window may an alteration [unconfirmed]; late 1970's rehabilitation project

Landscape: dense undergrowth and shrubbery with mix of non natives and ornamentals; some taller trees; flower garden

## HISTORY

(Chronological, descriptive history of the property from its construction through at least the historic period [preferably to the present])

George and Martha Draper had a large family, a number of whom made their livings in Canemah in the 1880's. George Draper was born in New York in 1823, and he served as a school teacher in Canemah. This is one of a number of Draper houses. The house was also owned in the 1890's by Daniel and Lena Klemsen. One of George and Martha's sons, Harry E. Draper (b. Canemah, 9/25/1881) went to work after he completed his schooling at the Huntley Brother Drug & Bookstore in Oregon City. He then became a partner, and later owner. The business at the time of his death in 1940 was the Huntley-Draper Drug Co.
