



One (1) A-frame sign may be placed within the planter strip, sidewalk or right-of-way per frontage.

Further information regarding all allowable types, dimensions and placement of signs can be found at www.OCSignCode.org.

Current standards can be found in Chapter 15.28 of the Oregon City Municipal Code.

Placing Signs on the Sidewalk in Residential Areas of Oregon City






DESIGN

The sign must:

- Be an A-frame sandwich design
- Have a frame which made of wood, plastic or metal
- Be portable
- Not be illuminated
- Be no wider than 28 inches
- Be no deeper than 2 feet
- Be no taller than 3 feet
- Be no larger than 6 square feet per side

OTHER INFORMATION


- Hours of Placement:
Thursday-Sunday: noon - 8 p.m.
Tuesday: 6 a.m. - 1 p.m.
- Approval from the abutting property owner is required.
- No permit is needed.
- The City may remove any signs which do not meet the standards.

RULES FOR PLACING THE SIGN

Signs may not be placed in parking spaces, pedestrian or bicycle pathways, street corners, transit stops, curb ramps, at building exits or fire escapes, or any portion of the street. Signs may not obstruct pedestrian or ADA access or impede or hinder the vision of drivers or bicyclists.
