Signage Types Prohibited in Oregon City



EXAMPLES OF PROHIBITED SIGNS

- Public art murals
- Signs blocking traffic visibility or signage
- Flashing, revolving, animated or moving parts that change more than 3x per day
- Signs with lights flashing into roadway
- Signs on trees or painted on natural features
- Signs obstructing entrance or exit from any door, window or fire escape, alley, drive or fire lane
- Signs larger than 12 feet sq or 6 ft per side on an undeveloped parcel
- Abandoned or damaged signs
- Signs that emit sound, smell or vibration
- Confused with public traffic signs or highway id
- Large flags (as described in Oregon City Municipal Code Chapter 15.28.110.)




